



ITALY. Milan. January 10, 2016. Via Chiese 2, Hangar Bicocca. People leaving the Pirelli Hangar Bicocca Foundation, a space for contemporary art and culture, founded in 2004 as a result of a conversion of former Breda Elettromeccanica and Locomotive and Ansaldo Group industrial plants. On the left, "La sequenza", a sculpture by the Italian artist Fausto Melotti; in the background, one of the last Pirelli industrial plant still active in Bicocca.



ITALY. Milan. January 10, 2016. Via Chiese 2, Hangar Bicocca. Detail of the permanent installation "The Seven Heavenly Palaces" (2004) and museum staff walking in front of "Jaipur" (2009). Both works by the German artist Anselm Kiefer are hosted in the space Navate which was constructed between 1963 and 1965 and served as transformer department of Breda Elettromeccanica and Locomotive. In 2004 Pirelli purchased the space and turned it into a museum for contemporary art called Hangar Bicocca.

Orobica factory was built in 1920; its buildings are now used for fashion shows, photo shoots, conventions, film or television sets. ITALY. Milan. December 15, 2013. Participants at Bicycle Film Festival in the former Faema Factory, coffee and cappuccino machines maker, in Via Ventura - Lambrate district. Former industrial district which hosted, among others, Faema and Innocenti factories, Lambrate has deeply changed, becoming a space for art galleries, design and events.



ITALY. Milan. April 17, 2016. Design Week. Last days of "The Wandering School" a project by the Dirty Art Department, a master program of the Sandberg Institute in Amsterdam, hosted in the ex-city slaughterhouse, which has become the location of "Macao", an independent center for art, culture, research and the meetings of citizens committees. It is coordinated by an open assembly of artists and activists.



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ITALY. Milan. December 6, 2015. People attending concerts and Christmas market at BASE - a space for culture and creativity - located in the former industrial Ansaldo area, a big electromechanical plant founded in 1904.



ITALY. Milan. April, 2011. Design Week at Superstudio which has experienced many changes over the past century: from Army bicycle factory during the First World War, to machineries and electrical components factory in the Fifties, dried fruits, nuts, peanuts, dates wholesale in the Sixties, blacksmith, carpenter, scale merchant mechanic, turner, printer, small building contractor warehouse in the Seventies and, finally, to the current "citadel of the image" for creativity and events.

ITALY. Milan. August 23, 2016. MIC - Museo Interattivo del Cinema - a museum dedicated to the history of the cinema - has been located in the former "Manifattura Tabacchi" since 2012; that was a factory which produced cigarettes and tobacco products.



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ITALY. Milan. December 6, 2015. Branca Tower at Fratelli Branca Distillerie, one of the last factory still located in the city of Milan. The chimney has been painted by the Milanese street artists Orticanoodles to celebrate the 170th anniversary of the Distillerie.
